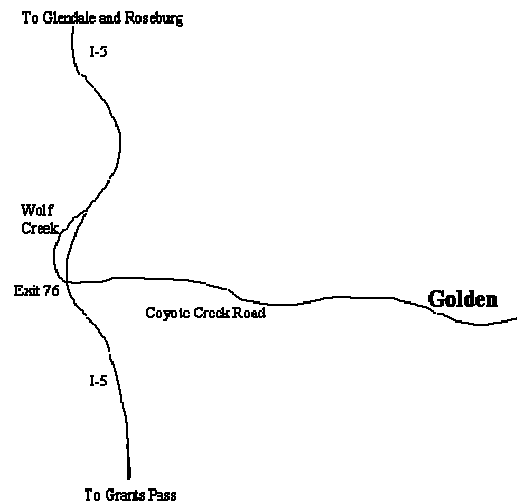

Welcome to the Golden National Historic District! We encourage friends, supporters and the public to use this landmark for special events and weddings.

Golden Church The church is a rustic church built circa 1890 by William Ruble when he brought his family to mine gold in the Coyote Creek Valley. The church is available for weddings and special events on a first come first served basis.

The Church serves as a beautiful setting for small weddings, vow renewals and family gatherings. Although Golden is rural and has few amenities, just three miles away the Wolf Creek Inn provides lodging and complementary services for receptions [541-866-2474].

Capacity There are 9 pews and capacity to seat approximately 45 people. The altar area is approximately 5 X 16 ft. The pews and pulpit are not fixed and can be shifted inside the church. Parking is available for less than 20 cars.

Logistics Electricity is available in the church on a limited basis. There is no running water nor sanitary facilities at the church. Rental of portable facilities is available through Grants Pass businesses.

Site Rules No smoking or drinking is allowed on the site. No nails or other hardware may be used in the church.

Services & Fees The site use fee covers basic maintenance and cleaning. Please submit a check with your request to secure your date. Full refund will be made if a request for cancellation is made one week in advance. Please check the web site for current use fee schedule; www.historicgolden.org
